Enviroscore Labelling

- IGD project – harmonised UK scheme
- Currently 4 main indicators
 - Climate Change
 - Water Use
 - Water quality
 - Land Use
- 100 point daily allowance (points or %?), traffic lights for 4 indicators?
- Virtual Label trial planned for late summer
- Possible in-store trials for 2023
- More limited number of categories than originally planned

EU Sustainable Food Systems

- Potential legislation being proposed for late 2023 – consultation just concluded
- Aims to define a ‘sustainable food system’
- Looking to set rules on sustainability labelling – but not create an EU label (?)
- Potentially covering nutrition, climate, environmental, animal welfare and social (including producer income)

Deforestation – UK & EU

- EU proposals being taken forward
- Growing concern around use of geolocation
- ECF working with Copernicus and Galileo systems
- Lobbying through MEPs and Member States
- Member States also questioning level of detail in their role
- Commission currently unmoved!
- Need for greater 3rd country action
