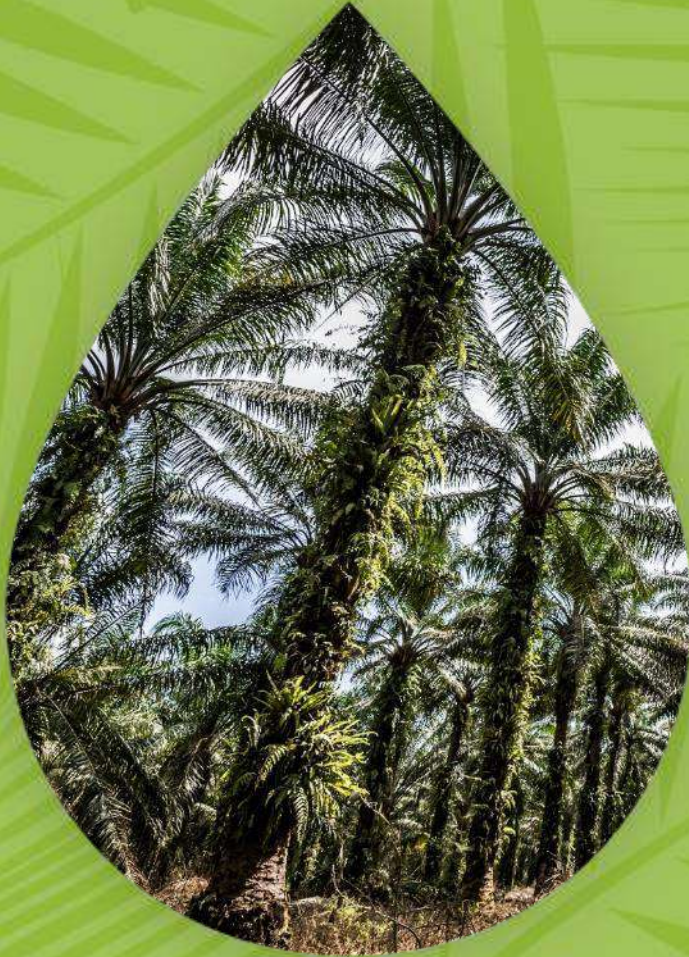

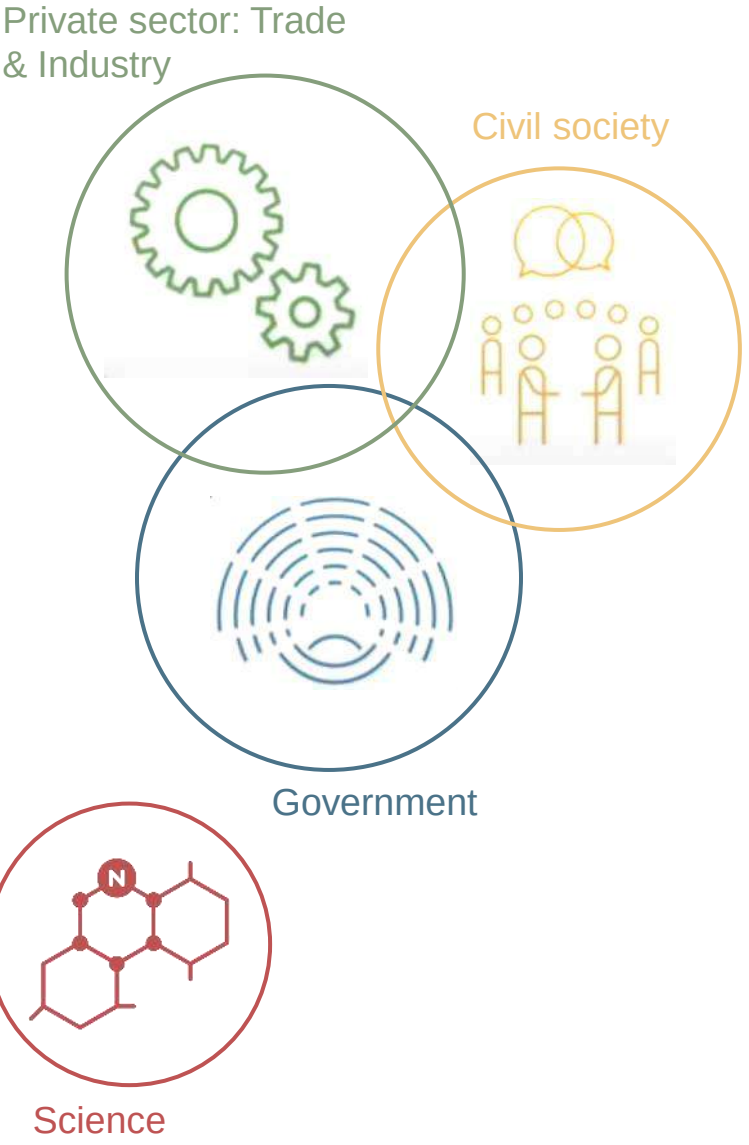

FONAP: A multistakeholder initiative



- Multistakeholder initiative (roughly 50 members): companies, NGOs, associations, federal government.
- Founded in 2013, a registered association since 2015.
- All members have committed to using 100% certified palm (kernel) oil.
- FONAP association is financed by membership fees.
- GIZ provides the secretariat for the association.



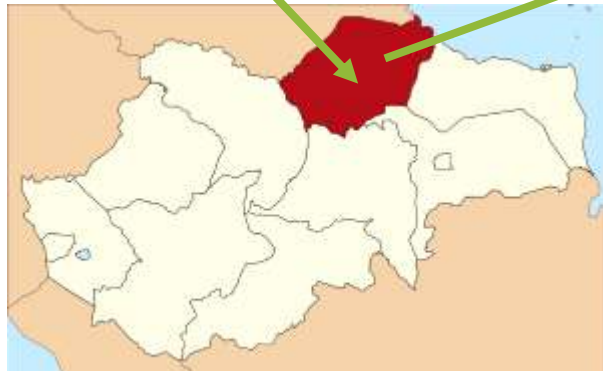

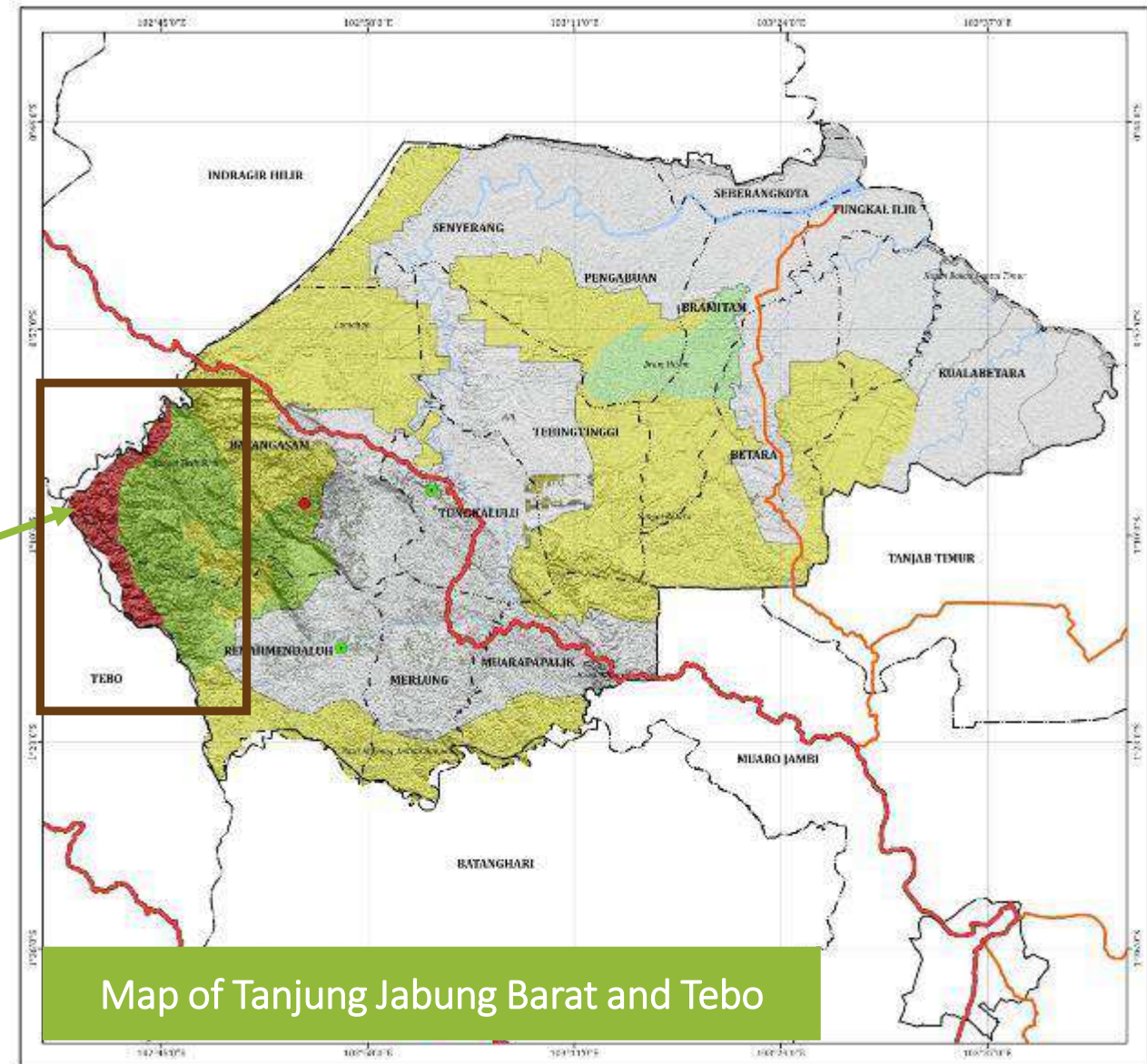

Impacts of the project

- Forest rehabilitation on 17 ha through social forestry practices
- Nursery establishment with three women groups to supply high-quality seedlings with economic value additional to oil palm
- Riverbank restoration using indigenous method “Lubuk Laranagan” including village Youth
- Trainings and adaption of regenerative agriculture of certified farmer groups



Insights from the ground

- Smallholders are willing to share data -> increase of transparency and access to stakeholders in VC
- Smallholders report difficulties selling their FFB to mill (traceability issues)
- Smallholders observe decreasing sales of smallholder certificates (RSPO-ISH)
- Providing geolocation remains a challenge for smallholders
